Return to In-Person Learning

As we return to in-person learning, we are asking families to remain vigilant so SSPP can continue to keep our building healthy. In following the IDPH protocols you are required to report to the school if:

1. Your child tests positive for Covid-19.
2. Your child is symptomatic with any of the symptoms on the COVID-19 checklist.
3. Your child is exposed to someone who is symptomatic with any one of the symptoms on the COVID-19 Self Check
4. Your child is exposed to someone who is COVID-19 Positive
5. Your child or someone in the household has a pending COVID-19 test.

Dear Parents and Families,

It has been another great week at SS. Peter & Paul. All of our classrooms finished up with their Iowa Basics Testing. We look forward to getting results soon. Today our teachers have the opportunity to receive their second dose of the COVID19 vaccine.



Throughout Lent we have continued to reflect with our students each day with a scripture story, a short reflection, a challenge question and a minute of silence. This has been a great opportunity for us to reflect and model the practice of prayer with our students.

As a parent, you are a critical faith leader for each of your students. Building prayer into the day-to-day of your household can build great fruits for your family. It can start with a simple conversation starter on the way to and from school. Some simple ideas:

1. Asking your student what prayer intercessions they have for the day.
2. Asking your student to explain concepts they are learning in religion class.
3. Discussing highs and lows of the week/day
4. Asking your student how they were able to use their gifts, as Jesus would have.

Although some of these conversations seem simple, they make great leaps for our children and their ability to live their faith.
